

SkillsUSA California State Officer Campaign Regulations

The SkillsUSA California Officer Candidate Selection committee prior to the first delegate session at the SkillsUSA California Conference must approve all campaign material.

Candidate may spend up to \$100.00 for campaign materials. You must submit all receipts at the time of the officer candidate testing and interviews.

Campaign Materials not allowed are:

- ?? Gum

Candy and all campaign material must be cleaned up at the end of each delegate session.

Candidates are allowed to use a table that will be set up in a designated area to put up a bulletin board (no larger than 25"x35") with fliers and other campaign materials.

Campaign materials and campaigning may begin at the first delegate session at SkillsUSA California State Conference. Any campaigning done before this may disqualify the state officer candidate.

Friday night campaign speech will be a three-minute speech covering the following information:

Saturday afternoon campaign speech is an extemporaneous speech that could be one of the following topics:
