OPENING & CLOSING CEREMONIES (Virtual)

Contest Description

Contestants will compete as a team of seven and give an oral presentation, reciting from memory, the opening ceremonies and closing ceremonies of the SkillsUSA organization as specified in the official SkillsUSA Opening and Closing Ceremonies Technical Standards.

Students will compete in this competition live over the Zoom platform on January 9, 2021. Students should be ready to present at their scheduled time. The contestant schedule will be emailed to the advisor/contestants by Friday, December 11, 2020. Changes cannot be made to scheduled time slots. Resumes must be submitted to SkillsUSA California by January 2, 2021 (details to follow).

At the Regional Level, teams do not have to be in the same room and can compete from several locations. Teams will not be judged on Room Set Up, Team Entrance, Group Seating, Group Standing, or Team Exit. Teams should remain standing or sitting the entire time so as to remain in view of the camera. Team members should be prepared to cover for a team member in case of Technical difficulties. Teams will have a total of 18 minutes to present the Opening & Closing Ceremonies-teams will be stopped at 18 minutes.
