



## Regional 2020-2021 Contest Catalog

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### **QUIZ BOWL (Virtual)**

#### **Contest Description**

Contestants will compete as a team of five responding to questions in all areas related to academic knowledge, professional development, and current events. Teams will compete against other teams of five. Participants will take a test prior to Live Rounds. There may be multiple rounds (Preliminary and Final) dependent on the number of contestants and Quiz Bowl Platform capabilities. The test will be used to qualify for Preliminary Rounds, if needed. Preliminary Rounds will have 50 questions. The Final Round will have 100 questions.

**Students will compete in this competition live over the Zoom platform on January 23, 2021.** Students should be ready to compete at their scheduled time. The contestant schedule will be emailed to the advisor/contestants by Friday, December 11, 2020. Changes cannot be made to scheduled time slots. **Resumes must be submitted** to SkillsUSA California **by January 9, 2021** (details to follow).

#### **Knowledge Performance**

This contest will not include a knowledge exam.

#### **Skills Performance**

Teams will demonstrate communication skills, teamwork, problem-solving and time-management skills by determining and presenting the answer to each question clearly *within the five-second time frame*.

#### **Scoring Guidelines**

Written Test	200 points
