# EXTEMPORANEOUS SPEAKING (Virtual)

### **Contest Description**

This contest follows all National Standards & Guidelines.

Contestants will compete individually. Contestants will have five minutes to organize the content of their speech in the preparation breakout room. The contestant will create a speech, of 3 - 5 minutes in length, using the prompt provided, and will present immediately afterward.


Students will compete in this competition live over the Zoom platform on January **16, 2021**. Students should be ready to present at their scheduled time. The Team schedule will be emailed to the advisor/contestants by Friday, December 11, 2020. Changes cannot be made to scheduled time slots. Resumes must be submitted to SkillsUSA California by January 9, 2021 (details to follow).

# **Regional Competition**

Contestants enter the preparation breakout room one at a time where they are given a speech topic. They will prepare their speech and be linked to a Breakout Room with their Panel of judges to deliver their speech. Contestants will be judged on voice, mechanics, platform deportment, organization, and effectiveness.

• Name Identification (person, school, city, state): -5 points each

**Opening:** Speaker is engaging, addresses prompt

**Voice:** Voice is well modulated and controlled, and carries the rhythm of the speech **Platform Deportment:** Speaker is poised and demonstrates good control of movement **Organization:** Speech is well organized, and the organization can be easily followed **Mechanics:** Proper grammar is used and diction is clear

**Closing:** Closing provides a clear and solid conclusion and summary of the speech **Effectiveness:** Assigned topic is covered, and the purpose of the speech is clear and achieved

# EQUIPMENT AND MATERIALS

# Supplied by the technical committee:

- Prompt
- Stopwatch (1 per Judge)
- Time cards: (Green: 3 minutes, yellow: 4 minutes, red: 5 minutes)

# Materials Required by Contestants:

- 1. PDF of Resume (SkillsUSA format)
- 2. Memorized quotes for possible use (not written down prior to preparation time)

3. Computer with high-speed internet capability and camera to use applications such as Zoom. The minimum recommended internet bandwidth speeds for joining Zoom meetings, accessing on-demand curriculum and other online operations is 2.0 Mbps up and down.
