MEDICAL MATH (Virtual)

Contest Description

Contestants demonstrate their knowledge of general math concepts used in the healthcare fields. Students will complete an online test that may include the use of ratio/proportion, dosage calculation, metric and household equivalents, Roman numerals, abbreviations, and general math including percentages and other medical math-related problems.

Regional Competition

Evaluates the ability to understand and solve mathematical problems commonly used in various health care settings.

Students will complete the exam electronically on January 16, 2021. Students should be ready to take the exam at their scheduled time. The schedule and times will be emailed to the advisor/contestants by Friday, December 11, 2020. Changes cannot be made to scheduled time slots. Resumes must be submitted to SkillsUSA California by (details to follow).

Official Dress is NOT required for Regionals. Clothing must be unbranded with no words, images, or logos. SkillsUSA or SkillsUSA California attire is recommended.
