# MEDICAL MATH (Virtual)

#### **Contest Description**

Contestants demonstrate their knowledge of general math concepts used in the healthcare fields. Students will complete an online test that may include the use of ratio/proportion, dosage calculation, metric and household equivalents, Roman numerals, abbreviations, and general math including percentages and other medical math-related problems.

#### **Regional Competition**

Evaluates the ability to understand and solve mathematical problems commonly used in various health care settings.

**Students will complete the exam electronically on January 16, 2021.** Students should be ready to take the exam at their scheduled time. The schedule and times will be emailed to the advisor/contestants by Friday, December 11, 2020. Changes cannot be made to scheduled time slots. Resumes must be submitted to SkillsUSA California by (details to follow).

- All competitors must create a one-page resume (SkillsUSA format) and submit an electronic copy to the judges prior to competition. Failure to do so will result in a 10-point penalty.

Official Dress is NOT required for Regionals. Clothing must be unbranded with no words, images, or logos. SkillsUSA or SkillsUSA California attire is recommended.
