INTERNET OF THINGS AND SMART HOME (Virtual)

Contest Description

The purpose of this contest is to evaluate each contestant's preparation for employment and to recognize outstanding students for excellence and professionalism in the field of home technology integration. This contest is open to active SkillsUSA members enrolled in programs with computer networking, telecommunications cabling, home theater installation, electronics applications and/or electronics technology as the occupational objectives. Contestants will complete an online exam/contest in lieu of an in-person competition.

Regional Competition

Students will complete the exam/contest electronically on **January 30, 2021**. The schedule and times will be emailed to the advisor/contestants by Friday, December 11, 2020. Changes cannot be made to scheduled time slots. Resumes must be submitted to SkillsUSA California by **January 30, 2021** (details to follow).

Knowledge Performance

The contest includes a written knowledge exam to assess knowledge of residential electronics installation and maintenance including smart house technologies. The exam will also include questions related to the SkillsUSA framework.

Clothing Requirements

Official Dress is NOT required for Regionals. Clothing must be unbranded with no words, images, or logos. SkillsUSA or SkillsUSA California attire is recommended.
